# What Plastic Reboot Is Designed to Achieve

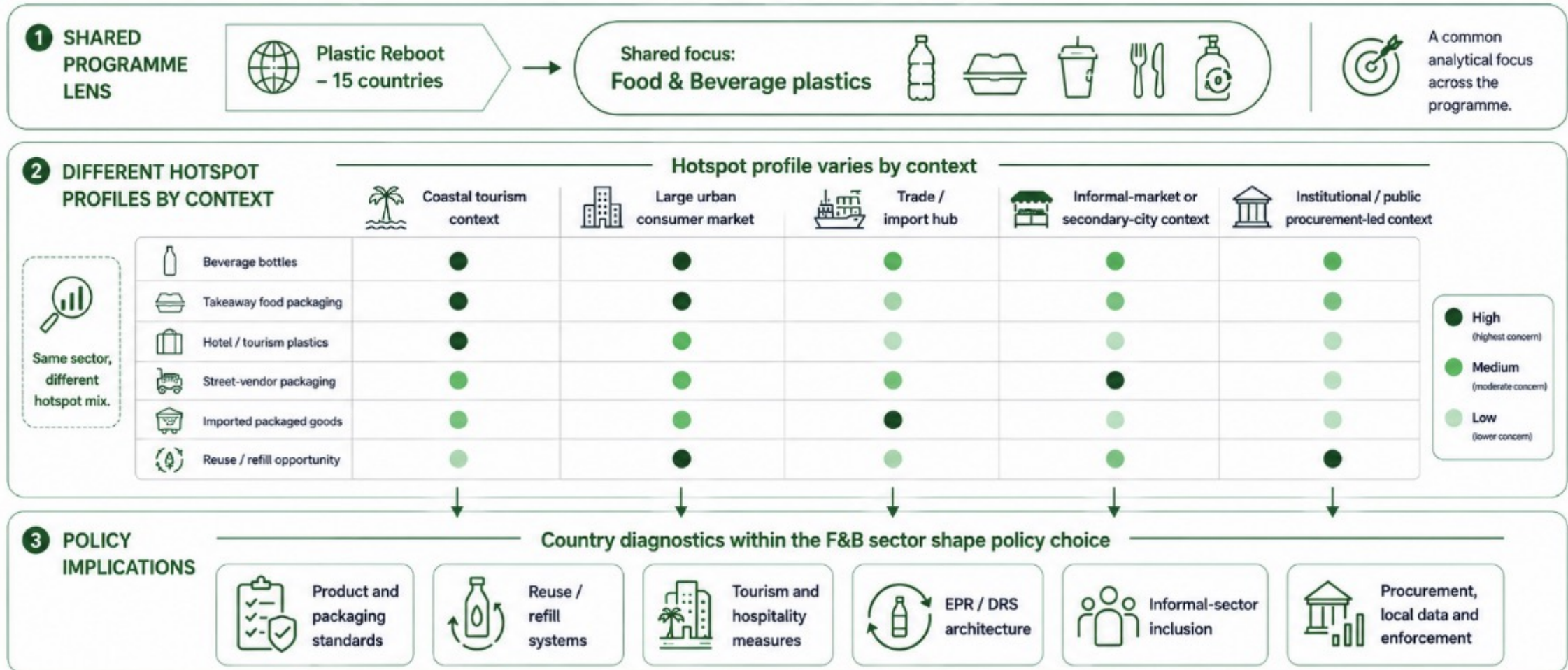
Transitioning towards a **circular economy** for plastics in **the food & beverage** sector to prevent **plastic pollution**.

## Why

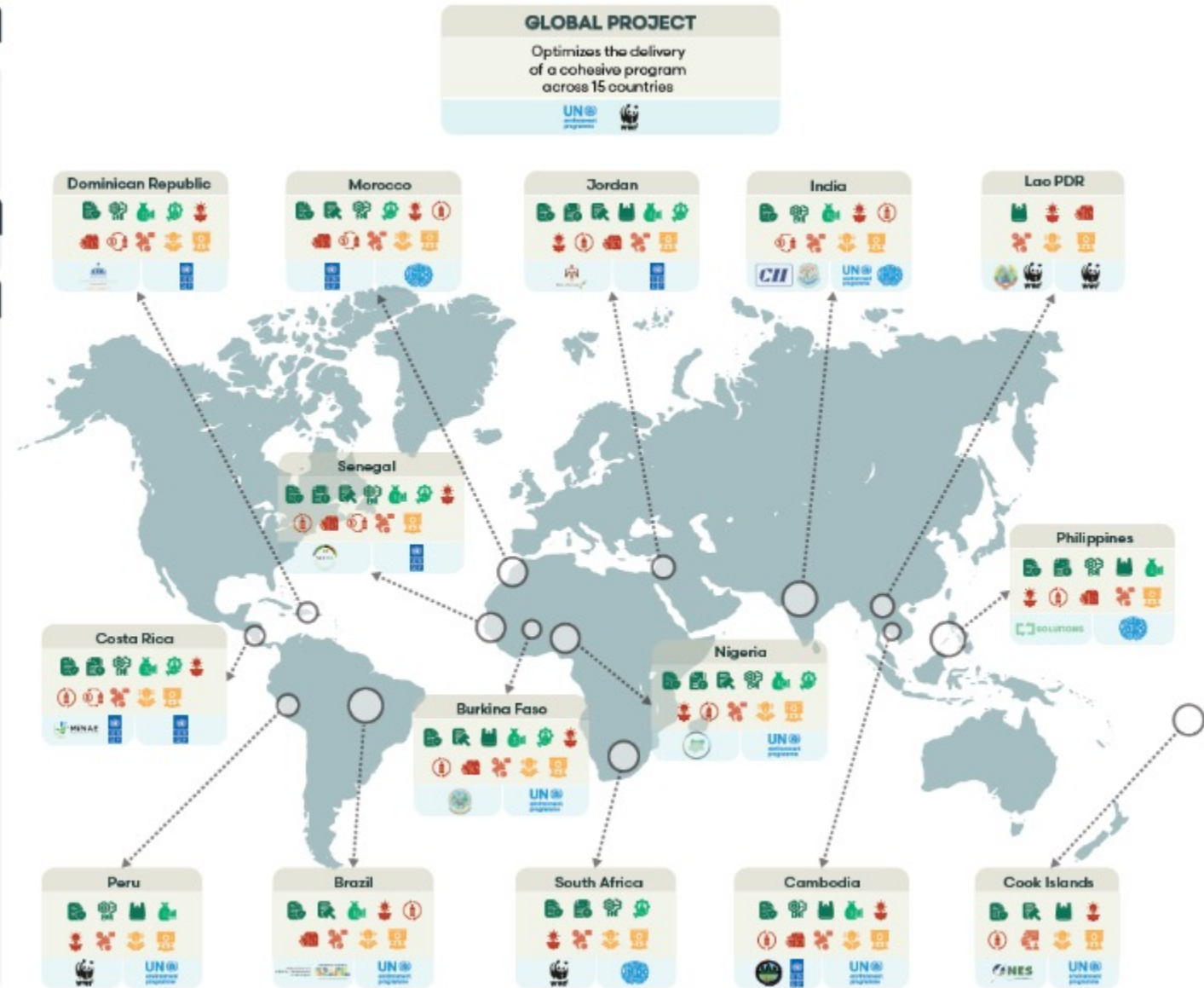
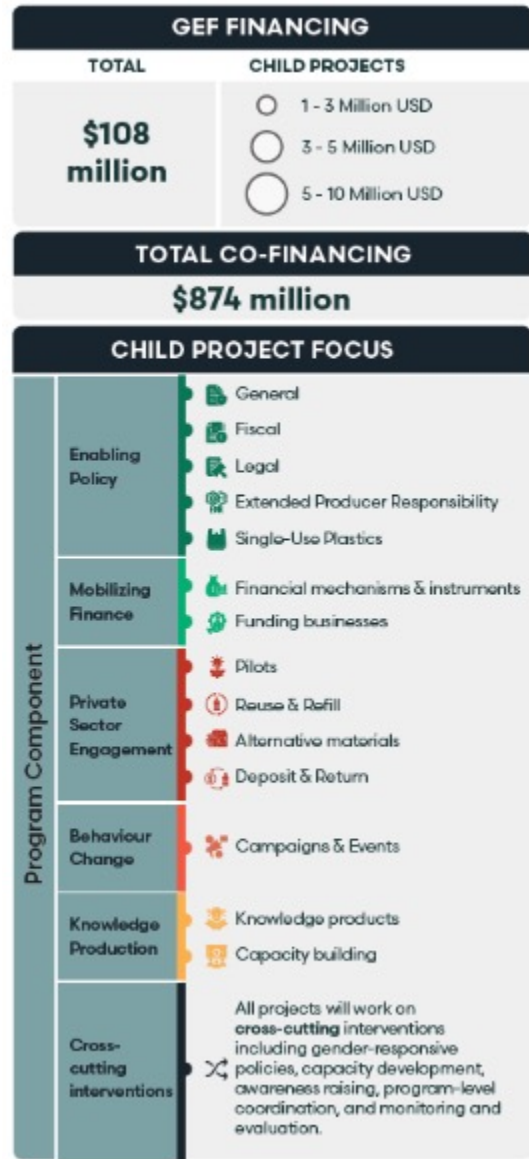
- Plastic pollution is a global and also a local problem

- **Packaging, including food & beverages, makes up ~ 40% of plastic waste.**



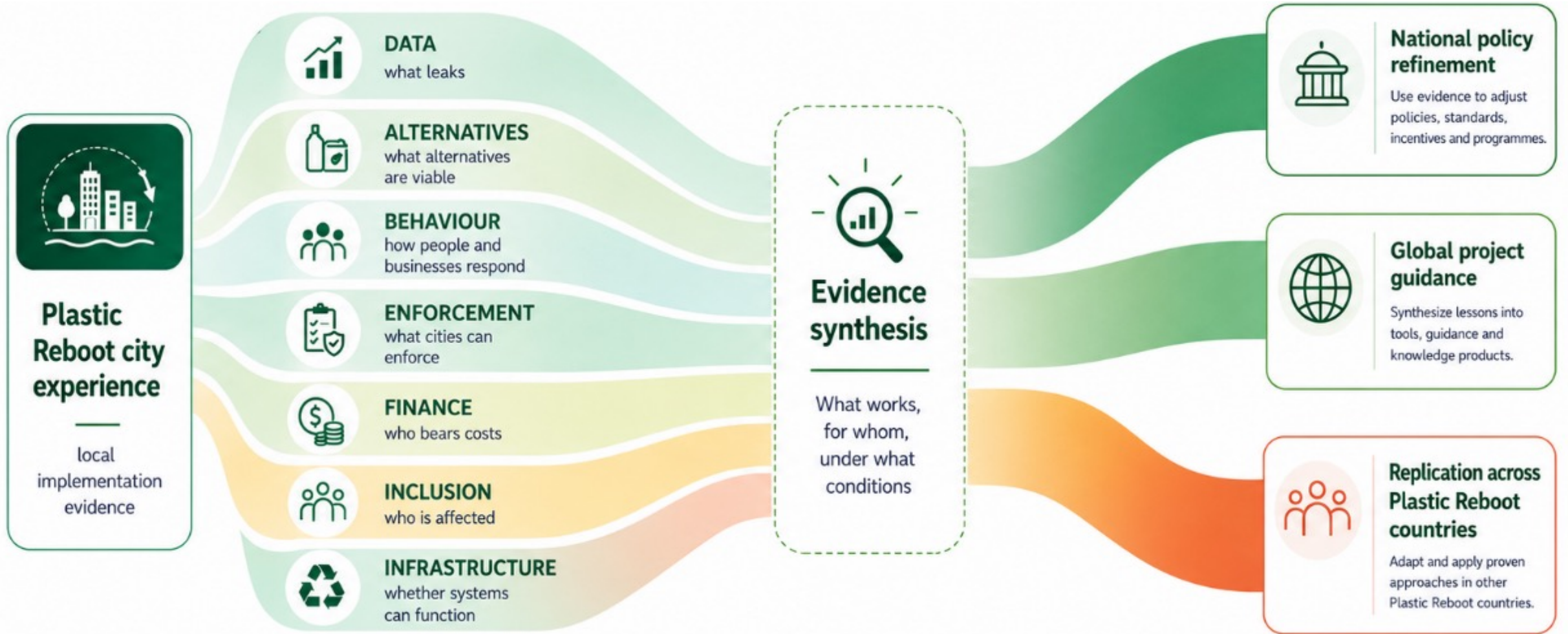

Continued investments to **catalyze an ambitious and comprehensive global response to the plastic pollution crisis**

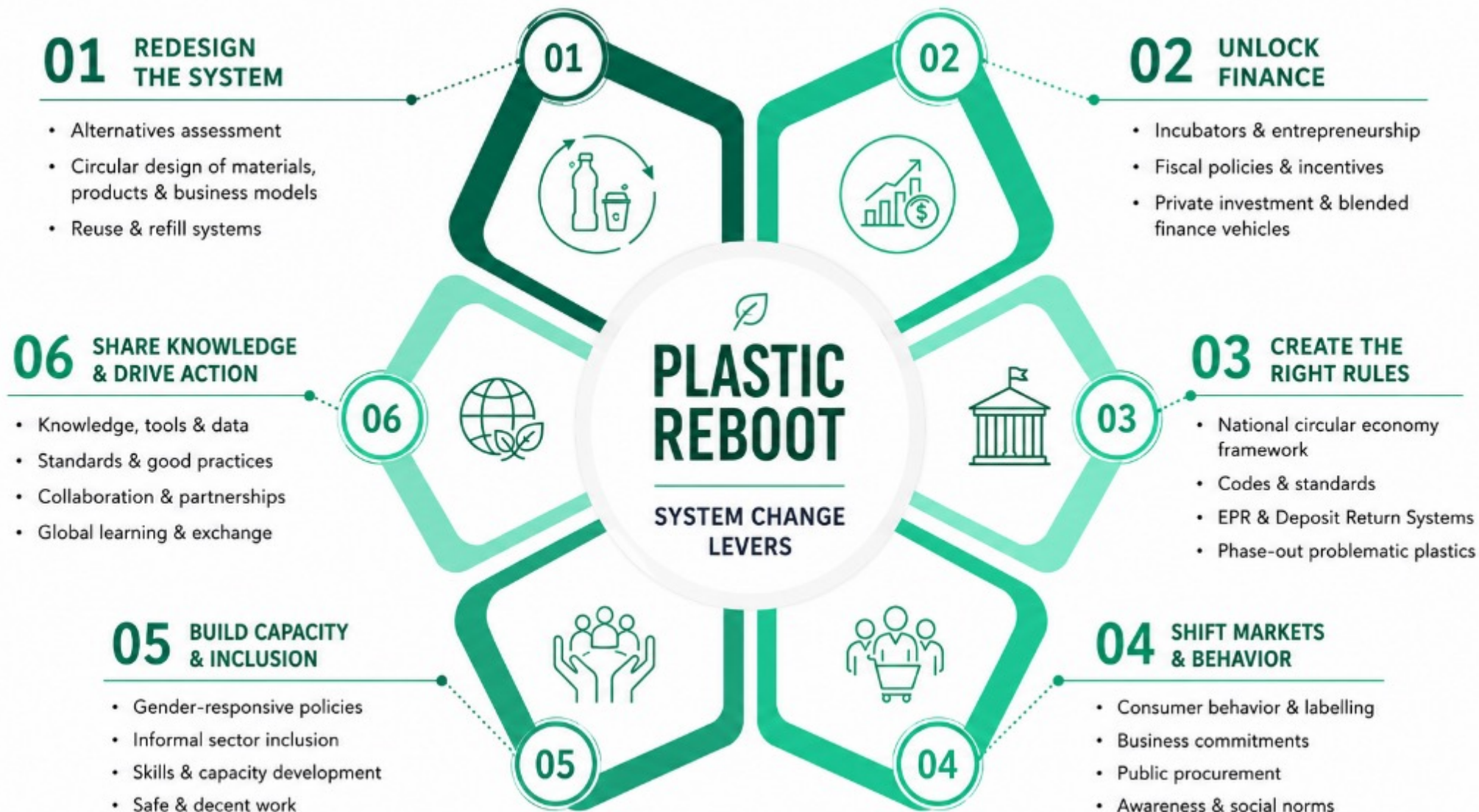
The proposed GEF-9 Integrated Program will:
