CITY PLANO OF GREEN (WITH CITY PLAN FOR CONSERVATION AND RESTORATION OF THE ATLANTIC FOREST - PMMA): Ensure the quality, quantity and distribution of Green Areas, guaranteeing their social and ecological functions, aiming at improving ecosystems and quality of life for the population of the municipality of Campinas (2016-2026)



CITY PLAN OF WATER RESOURCES: Ensure the quantity and quality of water, enhancing potential and reducing water vulnerability in the Municipality of Campinas (2016-2026)



CITY PLAN OF ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION: Make the social actors linked to Environmental Education recognize and connect in the universe of the Campinas Network of Environmental Education (2017-2026)



ACTION PLAN FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONNECTIVITY AREA OF METROPOLITAN REGION OF CAMPINAS: covering 20 cities and promoting the integration of biodiversity at the regional level through linear parks, ecological corridors, urban afforestation and protection of wild fauna

SUMMARY OF ACTIONS FOR THE CITY'S ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

2023-2026 goals

- Deploy 8 new linear parks with Solutions based in Nature
- plant recovery in 100 hectares through ecological corridors
- expand the sustainable rural sanitation program to 300 properties
- → finalize management plans for 2 protected areas
- institute a municipal policy for green areas and conservation units
- expand the payment for environmental services program
- → elaborate the CITY CLIMATE ACTION PLAN





SUMMARY OF ACTIONS FOR THE CITY'S ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

Another goals

- → Expand the 88 km of cycle paths to **180 km**
- → new bidding process for concession provides for the gradual replacement of more than 40% of conventional buses for electric or less polluting and low-carbon technologies.
- Public-Private Partnership (PPP) for Public Lighting Services: Forecast of a 64% reduction in energy consumption





Environmental Agreements and Commitments focused on the biodiversity, climate and resilience agenda



National alliances dedicated to taking systematic measures and increasing public support in tackling the global climate crisis, in order to help countries comply with the commitments agreed in the Paris Agreement.



The São Paulo Environmental Agreement is an initiative of the State of São Paulo and aims to encourage companies from São Paulo, associations and municipalities to assume voluntary commitments to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, in order to contain global warming below 1.5°C.



Race To Zero is a global campaign of ONU that seeks to engage governments, businesses, investors, academics and civil society leaders to achieve zero net greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.

Subnational Governments around the world to contribute to the negotiation of the New Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework.



Declaration of Barranquilla: an agreement that included 17 cities to create a new urban development model that takes biodiversity and sustainability into account, through the creation of the Network of BiodiverCities in Latin America and the Caribbean.



1st Brazil Resilience Center by the Global Coordination Committee of the Making Cities Resilient Initiative (MCR2030) and the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction - UNDRR
