The Sustainable Cities Integrated Approach Pilot is a Global Environment Facility (GEF) program which promotes an integrated approach to sustainable development. Supported with \$151 million in funding during GEF's 6th replenishment cycle, the program has development projects in 28 cities across 11 countries which are guided by implementing agencies and local executing agencies. The projects are tied together by the Global Platform for Sustainable Cities (GPSC).
