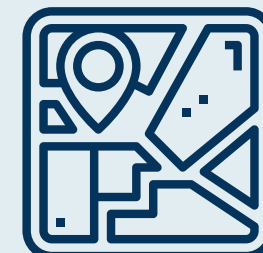
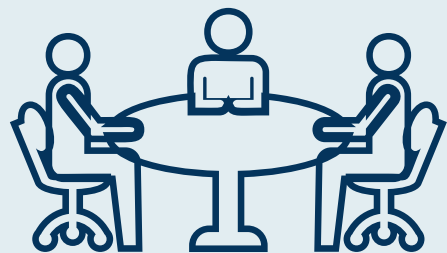

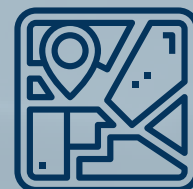


STENGTHENING DIALOGUE

We seek to create an instance for urban integrated planning of Asuncion's metropolitan area, involving all key stakeholders like the municipalities and central government institutions.

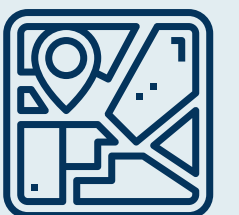




INTEGRAL METROPOLITAN APPROACH

A COMMON GROUND

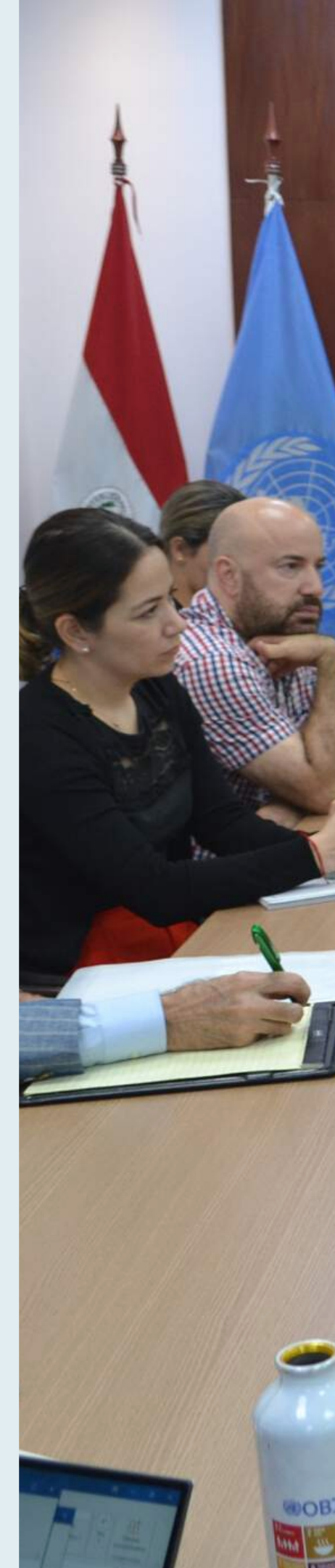
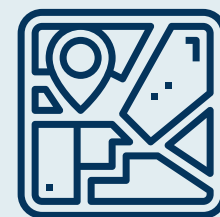
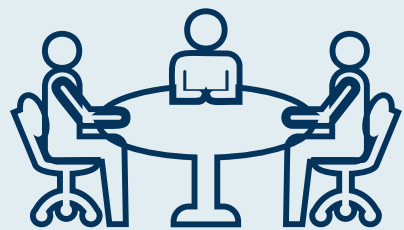
The concept of an Autonomous Institute for Planning of Asuncion's Metropolitan Area (IAPAMA), was initially conceived as a high-level technical body with competencies in urban planning, institutional development, capacity building and development policies. The mandate would be to lead inter-institutional and intersectoral coordination in Asuncion's Metropolitan Area and facilitate the implementation of each of the eleven cities' Sustainable Development Plan (PDS).

- Academia.



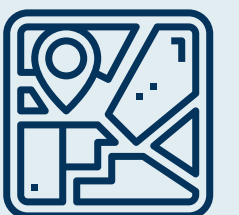


INTEREST AND PARTICIPATION

REACHING A CONSENSUS

There was an initial agreement regarding the need to create the space for coordination, planning and monitoring of investments in infrastructure projects that would take place in Asuncion's Metropolitan Area (AMA).

In order to continue in this direction, key stakeholders signed a Letter of Intent, seeking to strengthen the process started by the Project and created a roadmap to consolidate the idea of establishing the IAPAMA.

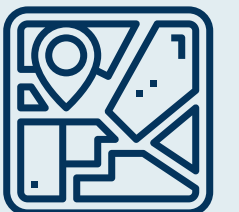

One of these stages is the revision of the legal framework, since population growth and development of current municipalities demand an integrated vision of the metropolitan area for decision-making and investment processes.

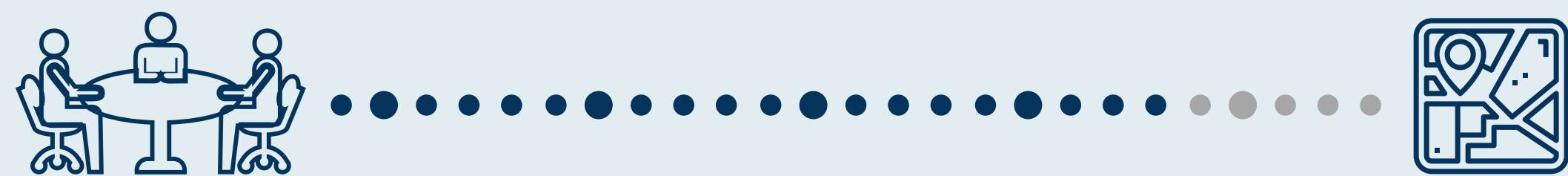
This represents a major paradigm shift in municipal and central government management.

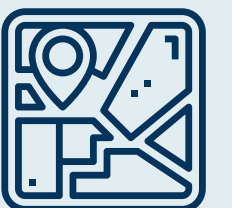

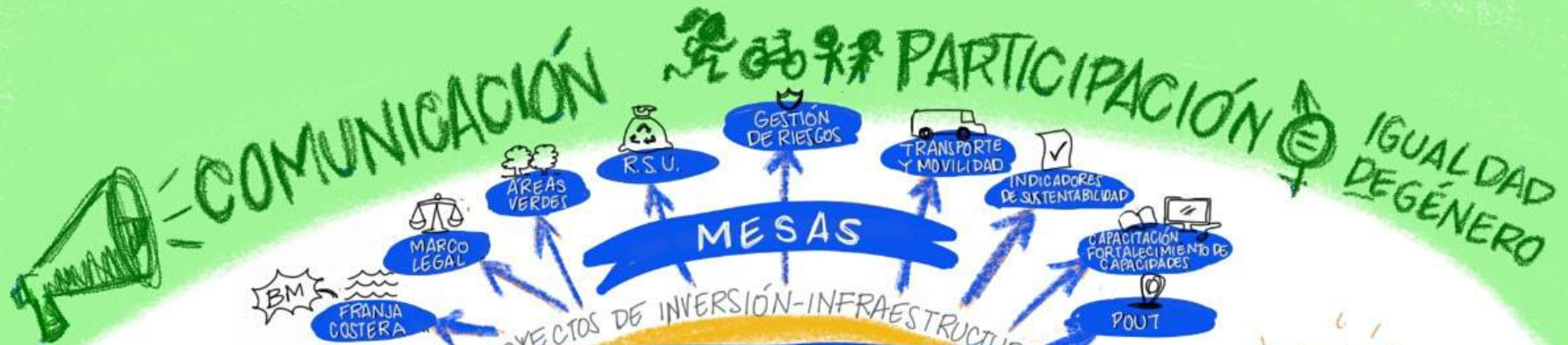
ARTICULATING THE PLATFORM
