


- Deep-dive learning and webinar series for cities: learning and sharing good practices


Project preparation support and investment

- Aim: Influencing the portfolio development of the financial institutions and supporting selected Lighthouse Cities in the project design for investment
- Modality of delivery:
 - Expert support for project design that enhances nature-based solutions and green urban infrastructure
 - Developing green/blue infrastructure investment framework
 - Engaging financial institutions (MDBs, regional and domestic financial institutions) and supporting new asset/product development
 - Facilitating private sector engagement at the national level
